## RULES & REGULATIONS

REMEMBER TO ENTER FROM MULBERRY STREET GATE ONLY!

Entry forms will be returned if ALL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS are not complied with.

**NO ENTRY FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS SIGNED BY CONTESTANT AND WAIVER SIGNED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN, WITH PARENTS SIGNATURE NOTARIZED BY NOTARY PUBLIC OR COPY OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. Cashiers Check or Money Order ONLY!**

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than August 19TH, 2011
2. Entry fees in the correct amount MUST accompany entry forms. **Stock and office fees WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.** Absolutely NO REFUNDS for any reason after August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Call back August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011 9am to 7 pm **NO CALLS AFTER 7:00 pm (530)534-5736**  
**RODEO ORDER ON WEBSITE.**
3. Contestants must be no older than (19) years and no younger than (3) years as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 to compete in rodeo events. Proof of Birth must accompany entry. This will be returned to contestant when number is picked up.
4. Admission fee at the gate is **\$5.00; each contestants name will be on a list at the gate. Contestant numbers must be picked up at the Rodeo office Saturday and Sunday between 7 am and 8 am for slack, between 10 am and 12 pm for performance; Or prior to the rodeo or day of your performance. Secretary will be available for check-in on Friday evening between 7 pm and 8 pm.**
5. SLACK: SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. WE WILL RUN ALL NECESSARY SLACK. CONTESTANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BEING AVAILABLE AT THESE TIMES. **Slack will start promptly at 9am and the Rodeo starts promptly at 1pm Saturday and Sunday.**
6. **GROUND RULES MEETING 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO ALL PERFORMANCES INCLUDING SLACK.**
7. NO RIDES IN PEE WEE EVENTS.
8. AFTER INITIAL ENTRY TO THE EVENT YOU MUST HAVE YOUR BACK NUMBER WITH YOU OR YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY.
9. During competition back numbers MUST be worn or contestant will be DISQUALIFIED.
10. **DRESS CODE:** contestants must wear western attire in arena AND track and while on horseback. Failing to comply will result in DQ. Western Attire consists of cowboy hat or helmet, long sleeve shirt, western pants and boots. This includes anyone assisting inside the arena or track.
11. Chute Dogging: Out of Chute.
12. Awards as follows: Buckles for first in all events. **ALL-AROUND SADDLES TO SENIOR/JUNIOR BOY & GIRL, BUCKLES TO ALL AROUND YOUTH BOY & GIRL** Awards based on points won. Points based on a **10, 8, 7, 6...** (yes this is correct)
13. Sunday after the rodeo we will be presenting event buckles and All-Around Saddles to the contestants at our awards dinner.
14. **GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE:** Contestants ONLY must address all questions or problems to the Arena Director. Parent or other interested Person, who gets involved with the event director, judges, or other rodeo official, runs the risk of having the person whom they are trying to Assist get **DISQUALIFIED.**
15. All-Around tie breaker: 1. most money won in two or more events. 2. Entered in two or more events but winning the most money in a single event. Contestant winning most money in a single event. NOTE: Ground money will not be posted toward All-Around. Rule 16 applies to PRCA Rule Book.
- 16.33-1/3% will be deducted from all entry fees for office and stock fees.
17. **Team Ropers: Confirm partner BEFORE entering. No refunds if partner fails to enter. We will NOT find you a partner or call you if your Partner does not enter. Team Ropers, please cooperate. If your name is not listed on the draw in team roping your partner did not enter.**
18. Barrel Racers: One pivot in arena allowed before advancing toward first barrel. Raking will be done per discretion of the Arena Director.
19. You will be disqualified for sharing horses between contestants Pole bending, Single Stake and Barrels only. Only one horse may compete in THESE EVENTS ONLY per the Red Bluff Jr. Roundup.
20. All Mutton Busting and Dummy Roping contestants must have entries postmarked no later than August 19<sup>st</sup>, 2011. No sign-ups on either day of the rodeo. There is a \$10.00 entry fee. A silver buckle will be awarded each day in each event for first place.
21. An additional fee of \$20.00 will be added to each contestant's entry form to pay for office fees.
22. All contestants shall comply with the rules. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in DISQUALIFICATION. **JUDGES WILL MAKE THE FINAL DETERMINATION.**
23. When staying at the Fair Grounds RV and Tent fees need to be paid for in advance or to the Rodeo Secretary before setting up your camp, you will receive your passes at that time. \$10 penalty if not paid prior. Any vehicle staying overnight must display a RV pass in front window of vehicle.

**Rules & Entry Forms are subject to change per discretion of the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Association**, all changes will be posted before and at the Rodeo. Details will be given at Grounds Rules Meeting. We are looking to parents and family members wanting to see if anyone would like to help with the Rodeo or be willing to join the Rodeo Association.
